1-1617/9 Chairman's welcome. In the absence of Councillors Elson and Buckingham Councillor Kirton was elected to Chair the meeting.

3-1617/9 To receive and accept apologies for absence: Councillors Elson and Buckingham sent their apologies due to previous commitments

4-1617/9 To receive and sign as a true record the minutes of the meeting of 24th January 2017 (*Circulated*) These were signed as a true and accurate record of the meeting.

5-1617/9 Planning Matters

To discuss and form a response to Application DC/17/0197/FUL Construction of a first-floor side extension, demolition of existing outbuilding and erection of replacement for Mrs Locke 55 The Street Brandeston. It was noted that the application included adding another storey to the west end of the existing house and would take some light from an adjoining property. The major change is to the original shed that stands on the western side of the house, which will be replaced with a car port Councillors/workshop. Councillors concluded that consent should be given.

DC/17/0385/FUL Mr and Mrs C Hutson The Old Police House Low Street Brandeston. Conversion of attached garage to shower room, utility room and store (Variation of condition 3 of planning permission C/04/1696). The Clerk had received this Application on the morning of the meeting. It was decided that this was not contentious and would make no outward change to the house. Councillors recommended that consent be given.
