Minute of the meeting of Brandeston Parish Council held on Tuesday 31st May at 7.30pm in the committee room of the Village Hall.

1-1617/2 Welcome from the Chairman

There were no members of the public.

2 -1617/2 To receive any Declarations of Interest

There were none.

3-1617/2 To receive and accept apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillors Churchill, Norman and Kirton.

4-1617/2 To receive and sign as a true record the minutes of the meeting of 9th May 2016

5-1617/2 Planning Matters

- a) To consider a response to application DC/16/2027/FUL. Consent sought for a single storey flat roof extension to Rawlinson's end for Dr and Mrs Campbell. The Councillors resolved to support this application.
- b) To consider a response to application DC/16/1884/FUL. Consent for Mrs Aitcheson to demolish existing outhouses to the Queen Public House, building on the footprint 4 remote bedrooms for 'The Queen' including upgrading toilet facilities for the existing camping area. Installing new patio doors and associated decking to the dining area. Extend and upgrade existing kitchen.
 Comments: The plain glass sliding doors are totally out of character with the design of the existing windows. Councillors suggest that replacing the existing larger window with small paned French windows would be much more desirable. The size of the wooden decking area is too large for the footprint of the building. The Council felt the deck should reduce in scale and the proposed wooden decking be replaced with stone slabs. There were no objections to the proposal to demolish the old outhouses and build new accommodation or with the extension to the kitchen area.
- c) To consider a response to application DC/16/2061/FUL Installation of no. 8 photovoltaic solar panels on the roof of a recently constructed (c.2014) single car garage. The Council has no objection to the proposal for solar panels.
