My partner Ffiona Lewis and I have carefully thought through our position on your request. As we are new to the village, we are anxious not to stand in the way of anything seen to be for the benefit of the local community, and thank you for explaining the issues to us.

Following receipt of your letter, we met up with Alison and Colin Molyneux at the Priory, and discussed the situation with them.

Our view is that widening the road at the corner in our shared opinion is not going to help the situation, and could worsen it by enabling vehicles to travel faster round the corner. I do appreciate this does not chime with other views, but the four of us do share this point of view. We jointly feel that other measures, particularly the chevrons on the Molyneux side of the road, are likely to be far more effective.
