Whilst Brandeston Parish Council acknowledge that there is a presumption in favour of applications which support tourism in the area there are a number of issues with the use of this property arising from it being an unsupervised short-term AirBnb let. The PCllrs & parishioners acknowledge that if as and when the Queen Pub opens use of this property as a holiday let could be of benefit to the pub trade.

The parish council have requested that if ESC is to grant permission to regularise the use of the property as an Airbnb it should be conditional on ensuring a harmonious co-existence with the parishioners / residential occupiers;

- 1) Not to use the garden between the hours of 11pm 7am. (Music, sport, drinking & general socialising.)
- 2) To have a manager on-site to ensure that the rules are adhered to.
